AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY AUTHORITY TO (I) IDENTIFY INITIAL TRAINING PROVIDERS, AND (II) AUTHORIZE TRAINING PROVIDER EDITS

WHEREAS, the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (hereinafter “the Recovery Act”), signed into law by President Barack Obama on February 17, 2009 provides funds for adult employment and training activities, and

WHEREAS, a significant element of the Recovery Act involves training, and

WHEREAS, it is imperative that the applications regarding identification of eligible providers of training services (Ref: Section 122 of the Workforce Investment Act) be reviewed on a timely basis, and

WHEREAS, the State’s website, designed to comply with the Eligible Training Provider State List reporting requirements of the Workforce Investment Act of 1009, was recently attacked and is currently being reconstructed,

WHEREAS, as a result of these circumstances staff are requesting temporary authority to deny/approve initial requests by providers of training and authority to process edit requests of currently approved training providers,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the St. Lawrence County Workforce Investment Board (SLCWIB) that staff are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to process (i) initial training provider requests and (ii) edit requests of currently-approved training providers,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this authority shall continue throughout the life of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funds allocated for Employment & Training programs, or June 30, 2010, whichever is the latter, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that staff shall advise the SLBWIB of those training providers it has approved and shall request a formal approval by the Board at the Board’s next meeting.
