

Bricklayers, Masons, Plasterers Recruit Apprentices

Released March 24, 2009: The Bricklayers & Allied Craftworkers #2 (Ogdensburg) will conduct a recruitment from April 1, 2009 through March 31, 2010 for five bricklayer, mason & plasterer apprentices.

Applications can be obtained at The Work Place, 1222 Coffeen Street, Watertown, from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday; and at the St. Lawrence County One-Stop Career Center, 80 State Highway 310, Suite 8, Canton, from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday during the recruitment period.

The Committee requires that applicants:

- Be 18 years of age
- Have a high school diploma or general equivalency diploma (GED).
- Must be able to lift 50-100 lbs.
- Must have a valid driver's license to operate company vehicles.
- Must have reliable transportation to and from job sites and related instruction classes.
- Must be a six-month resident of Local #2 geographic jurisdiction as follows: All of St. Lawrence, Jefferson, and Lewis Counties, except the Lewis County townships of Constableville, Port Leyden, Lyons Falls, Turin and Redfield.

Apprentice programs registered with the Department of Labor must meet standards established by the Commissioner. Under state law, sponsors of programs cannot discriminate against applicants because of race, creed, color, national origin, age, sex, disability or marital status. Women and minorities are encouraged to submit applications for apprenticeship programs. Sponsors of programs are required to adopt affirmative action plans for the recruitment of women and minorities.
